KLUFC Parent Code of Conduct

Purpose

The purpose of this document is to set out the code of conduct of parents. It is to be read in conjunction with any additional Codes of Conduct which are published by Football Australia or Football Tasmania.

Parent Code of Conduct

As a parent I will:

- 1. remember that children play the sport for their enjoyment, and not mine;
- 2. encourage all children to participate, do not force them;
- focus on the child's efforts and performance rather than the result of the activity (that is, winning or losing);
- 4. encourage children to always participate according to the rules;
- 5. never ridicule, yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game;
- 6. remember that children learn best by example, so applaud good play by both teams;
- 7. support all efforts to remove racial, gender and religious vilification, verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities;
- 8. respect the match official's decisions and teach your child to do likewise;
- 9. show respect and appreciation to Club officials, including coaches, officials and administrators.
- 10. ensure any issues are raised through the correct channels;
- 11. not smoke or consume alcohol near the team bench (Technical Area) or sideline.
