Purpose

The purpose of this document is to set out the code of conduct of all players at the club. It is to be read in conjunction with any additional Codes of Conduct which are published by Football Australia or Football Tasmania.

Player Code of Conduct

As a player I will adhere to the following codes of conduct:

- 1. Play by the Rules and within the spirit of the game;
- 2. Do not argue with the match official. If you disagree, have your captain or coach approach the match official during a break in play or after the match is concluded;
- 3. Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players, deliberately distracting or provoking another person is not acceptable or permitted in any sport;
- 4. Maintain your focus and work hard for yourself and your team;
- 5. Be a good sport and be prepared to acknowledge good play whether it is from your team or the opposition;
- 6. Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player;
- Cooperate with your coach, team-mates and opponents. Without them, there would be no competition;
- 8. Play for your own enjoyment, and not just to please parents and coaches;
- 9. Remove all jewellery prior to training and match play, as it is a hazard to you and those around you;
- 10. Not accept or use any banned or unauthorised drug(s), including the consumption of alcohol at any time.
